Jodi Vaughan is celebrated as one of New Zealand's premier country music artists. Jodi is an entertainer whose career spans over five decades.

Born in Sydney in 1950, Jodi Vaughan moved to New Zealand in the 1970s and became one of the country's most beloved country music entertainers.

Career Highlights:

- Rose to fame after appearing on The Entertainers (1976).
- Starred in That's Country TV show in the 1980s.
- Frequent collaborator with Brendan Dugan and Gray Bartlett.
- Hit single "No Fool Like an Old Fool" stayed 10 weeks in NZ Top 40.
- Released 10 studio albums, including Rodeo Eyes and For the Love of Country (2022).

Awards & Recognition:

- Most Promising Female Vocalist (1982 NZ Music Awards).
- Benny Award winner (2023).
- Inducted into the Gore Country Music Hands of Fame (2024).

Recent Work:

- Down Under Girls! (2024) with Aly Cook as Sisters in Country — multiple No. 1 airplay hits in Australia.
- Continues to chart and perform, showcasing her songwriting and stage presence.



Aly Cook – Dynamic NZ & Australian Entertainer

Aly Cook is a New Zealand country-blues singer-songwriter from Nelson, known for her heartfelt songs and independent spirit. She blends country, blues, and roots music, releasing three self-funded albums on her own label, Te Aroha Records. She's won NZ Female Country Artist of the Year (2012), and several of her singles—like Midnight Cowboys, Red Dirt Road Trip, and Kimberley—topped the Australian country charts.

- Born and raised in Tahunanui, Nelson, Aly grew up in a musical household—her father performed as an opera singer, sparking Aly's own early musical passions, including piano lessons from age nine.
- She blends country, blues, folk, and roots genres, crafting richly melodic songs with emotional depth and strong harmonies.
- Aly independently crowd-funded all three of her albums and even released her own label, Te Aroha Records, in support of independent artists.

Aly has toured extensively in NZ, Australia, and Europe, and is a strong advocate for independent musicians. Though better known in Australia, she remains a standout Kiwi talent with global reach.



Marian Burns: Virtuoso Fiddler of New Zealand

Marian Burns is not only a virtuoso fiddler but also a passionate performer who brings joy and vitality to every stage she graces. Her performances are defined by technical brilliance, emotional expression, and a rare ability to engage audiences of all ages.

Marian has released a series of well-regarded albums, including:

- Just Fiddlin' Around
- The Paris Sessions – Produced in France, this project showcases her international collaboration with Jean Alain Roussel and features a sophisticated blend of fiddle traditions.

She has also composed music for children, classroom use, and theatrical performance—underscoring her versatility as a composer and arranger.

Through her decades of work in performance, education, and composition, Marian has become a cornerstone of New Zealand's musical identity—ensuring the fiddle continues to sing vibrantly across generations.

1. Booking & Payment

- A non-refundable deposit of NZD \$2,500 is required within three (3) days of booking confirmation to secure flights and accommodation. All group flights must be confirmed with Air New Zealand by 11 August 2025.
- After this date, fares will be subject to current market pricing, which will result in higher costs.
- To secure the quoted fare, please ensure confirmation is completed by the deadline.
- Bookings will not be guaranteed until the deposit is received.
- The final balance of payment is due 60 days prior to departure and is non-refundable.
- Payments made by MasterCard, Visa, Q-Card, American Express, or Diners Club will incur a credit card service fee.

2. Pricing

- All prices are quoted in New Zealand Dollars (NZD) unless stated otherwise.
- Tour pricing is based on twin-share accommodation. Single supplement rates are available on request.
- Pricing may be subject to fluctuations in currency exchange rates.
- Optional activities are available at an additional cost and are not included in the tour price.

3. Tour Viability

- A minimum of 15 passengers is required for the tour to proceed.
- If the tour is cancelled due to insufficient numbers or for any other reason, a non-refundable administration fee of NZD \$200 will be retained as a credit on your trip file for future travel.

4. Amendments & Cancellations

- Cancellation and amendment fees apply and vary depending on the time of the change or cancellation.
- If you cancel:
 - After deposit: Deposit is forfeited.
 - Within 60 days of departure: Full tour cost is forfeited.
- No refunds will be given for unused services once the tour has commenced.
